Kerry will get guidelines for separation of food prep sink and dish washing sink.

The remodel will start around August 6 to be completed by November1.

Chlorinator: Margaret moved that we buy the chlorinator system proposed by Dion at the December meeting. The motion was seconded and passed.

Minutes: Charles moved to accept the December minutes. The motion was seconded and passed.

Treasurer's Report: Charlotte reported a balance of \$96,136.79. She will void two uncashed checks; \$475 to Sha'anan Levy and \$625 to the Department of General Services (lease) from 2012. She suggested using part of the money in the checking account to open a second account to take advantage of a Bank of the West promotion that will save checking fees.

Charles moved that we split the funds between savings and checking and buy a \$50,000 CD. Th motion was seconded and passed. Glenn asked about receipts submitted by Matt Torrance for which he has never been paid. Glenn will have Matt contact Charlotte directly.

Charlotte has started to work on a budget. She incorporated the increase in camp fees. She asked for numbers for the kitchen and bathroom construction. We will vote on the budget in March.

Kerry asked counties to update the spring weekend schedule: March 4-5 Alameda March 31- April 2 Sonoma April 22-23 Contra Costa April 29-30 Marin June 4 Napa

Charlotte asked about fees for weekends. She has no record that they are being paid. We will decide in March if we will continue weekend fees or go back to offering the work incentive.
