Maintenance List

<u>Pool</u>

- Two drought damaged trees Fred will check in the spring.
- Sweep roofs
- Repair buckled fence behind the pool.
- Caulking
- Roto Rooter septic tank
- Rid-X in tanks (Wait for warm weather.)
- Put a clean out at the bathroom
- Repair sloping concrete east of the pool
- Fix cracks near the diving board
- Replace fascia board at the pool house
- Clean up wood debris behind the pool house

<u>Bridge</u>

- Loose railing
- Broken boards

Burnside

- Fire hose from hydrant at Woody's Circle to reach campfire.
- Clean up fire debris in creek
- Riprap creek bank behind campfire ring
- Build a fire ring
- Replace chicken wire barricade behind campfire ring
- Replace missing stair
- Repair broken benches (Marin)
- Backfill steps (Sonoma)

Woody's Circle

- Power wash and reseal benches
- Put away fire extinguisher

<u>Crafts</u>

- Light cover
- Replace linoleum floor

Nurse / Cooks

- Put away lumber (beams for bunks)
- Replace wooden toilet seat
- Clean gutters
- Paint gutters with Rustoleum
- Strap water heaters

<u>Girl's Camp</u>

- Repair steps from dining area to gate (Napa)
- Erosion control on hillside (Napa)
- Repair broken boards on bunks (Napa)
- Replace fir boards with redwood (Napa)
- Add bunks or extend existing bunk

Bathroom #1

- Fascia
- Replace screen
- Patch walls and paint (Charles F. Tammy)
- Remove ugly stump
- Replace roof panel

Bathroom #2

- Demo (Charles F. and Rex)
- Grind Stump
- Repair

Garbage Area

- Remove dead limbs
- Build a platform for garbage cans or buy a garbage trailer (Kerri will get prices)

Dining Area

- Seamless spray top for roof
- Replace fire extinguisher hooks
- Remove tape, staples, nails, wires, strings from posts and fascia (Sonoma)
- Replace brooms (Buy 24 brooms Half delivered at start of camp, half mid-way)
- Replace sign taken from the posts below the dining area
- Replace 5 tables (Marin)
- Replace metal tops on side tables by the outside sink
- Paint railing
- Fill in low spots on the floor where water collects.

Boy's Camp

- Replace broken boards on bunks
- Circulating pump
- Drain water heaters to remove sediment
- Remove horizontal limbs outside of fence.

<u>Kitchen</u>

- UL300 fire suppression system (Investigate used)
- Hood (Investigate used)
- Replace stainless steel counter
- Triple sink / prep sink
- Rodent proof pantry and cupboards Seal holes, new wall board, rubber sweep under door
- Upgrade shop vac
- Patch holes in floor
- Repaint floor
- Seal area between walls and floor

Fun in the Forest (From inspection report)

- Replace broken board on zig-zag
- Treat wooden elements with wood preservative
- Consider upgrading cable

Miscellaneous

- Repair / replace chlorinator
- Hang bee traps
- Reach out to Cal Fire regarding road repair, especially between the graveyard and parking lot
- Make sure kitchen is completely clean before Health Dept. inspection
