To whom it may concern,

The Office of the Alameda County District 1 previously awarded \$50,000 to fund kitchen upgrades at the Alameda County 4-H Camp facility that has historically been held at the Las Posadas Forest located in Angwin. The funds were provided for kitchen improvements to meet Napa Health standards. As a result of the Covid-19 Pandemic no Alameda 4-H Camp was held in 2020 or 2021. During this time period, Cal Fire did an evaluation of the infrastructure and facilities at the Las Posadas location and told 4-H that their camp could not be held there until the State was able to "bring everything up to code". This could cost millions of dollars and given their budget and other priorities it would be many years before 4-H could hold camp at Las Posadas again, if ever.

We are requesting that the Las Posadas 4-H Camp Board return the Donated funds and that the funds be given to Alameda County 4-H Leaders Council earmarked for "Alameda County Outdoor Camp Program".

Alameda County 4-H needs to restart camp at a new facility and begin the process of getting new families interested in sending their children to Camp. Alameda County District 1 Supervisor David Haubert and former Alameda County District 1 Supervisor Scott Haggerty are authorizing Alameda County 4-H to use the \$50,000 that was allocated for kitchen improvement at Las Posadas to be reallocated to Alameda County Camp program to restart the Alameda Camp Program.
